## Adult Classes:

New Business:

- Annita shared that a private party has been scheduled for December 3rd at 5 PM for the Farmer Family Practice staff. Art design of Christmas Gnome was selected by Ms Farmer and 10 x 20 canvas have been purchased. Dona will be leading the session and Annita will assist. Annita also shared that Owl drug has also expressed interest, but not scheduled .
